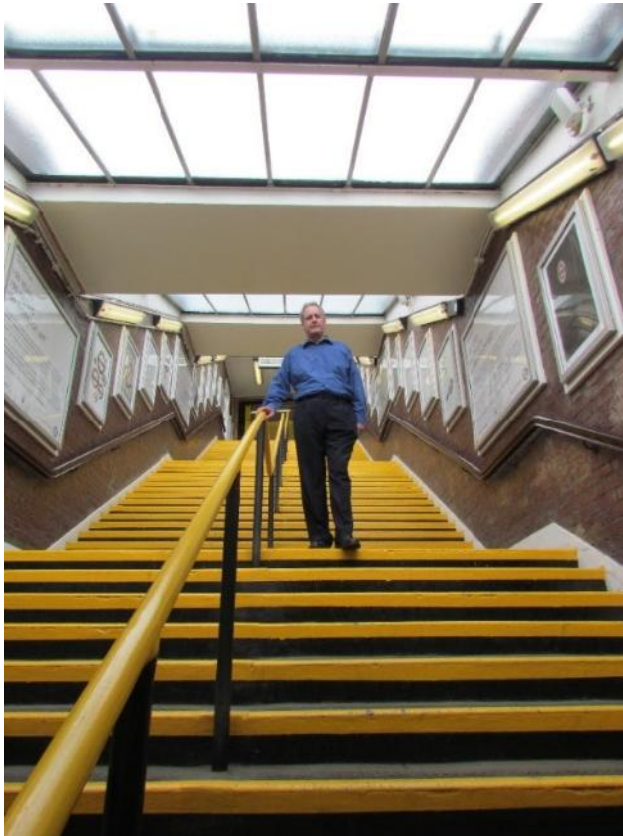


## Transport Accessibility Consultation Open

The Department for Transport and the Disabled Persons Transport Advisory Committee have opened a consultation on transport accessibility, which opened in August and will be open for comment until the **15th November 2017**.



I would imagine everyone locally will be familiar with the arduous long flight of steps at Stanmore Station (pictured), which claims to be disability accessible station via a ramp that a Paralympian couldn't get up, and the complete lack of options at Canons Park Station. I've been campaigning for a long time for improvements to these stations and I'm hoping to get a debate on this important subject granted in Parliament soon.

In the meantime, I would very much urge everyone to take part in the consultation and make it known that the lack of access for at these stations is blighting the lives of local residents.
